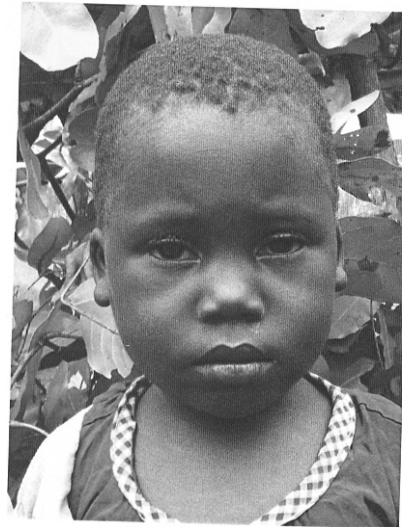

Some small items that Agness would enjoy...stickers, pencils, hair ribbons, coloring books, picture postcards and much more.

There is much more information that she has hand out and will be sure you have plenty of time to bring in items if you wish to. Also every month KFC will pledge \$35.00 to help provide access to resources like clean water, improved nutrition, basic health care, educational opportunities and economic development assistance. 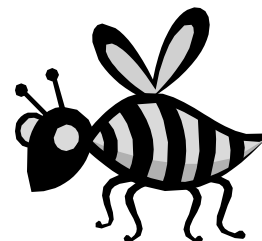


WESTERN ROUND UP
